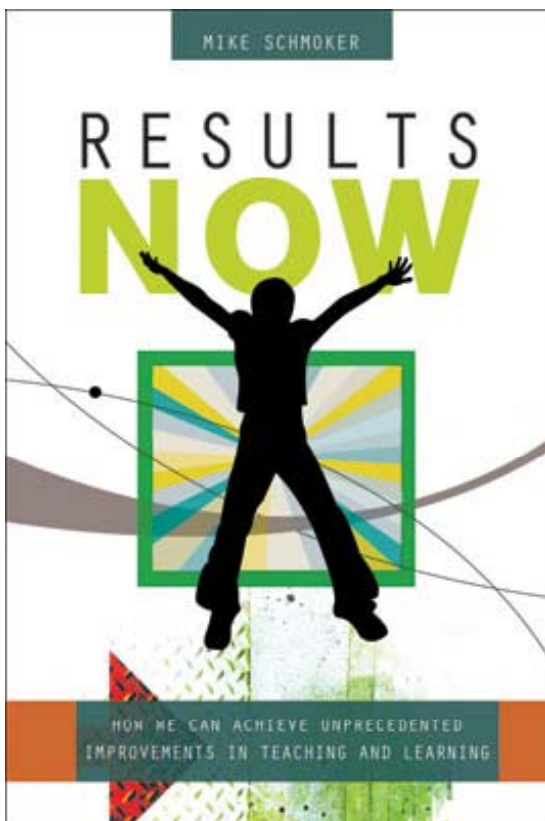

DIRECTIONS TO MACOMB SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL
1525 S. Johnson Road, Macomb, Illinois

From the West (US 136):

At the 3rd stoplight (Intersection of US 136 and Johnson Street), turn right (South).
At the jog in the road, turn right and then immediately left staying on South Johnson Street.
At the stop sign at the intersection of South Johnson and Grant Street, continue straight (South).
Macomb Senior High School will be on the left just past the football field.
Enter the furthest southern driveway entrance.

From the North (US 67):

At the 3rd stoplight coming in on US 67 (at the Amtrak station) continue (South) – you will now be on Lafayette Street.
At the intersection of Lafayette Street and Grant Street, turn right.
Continue to the stop sign and turn left.
Macomb Senior High School will be on the left just past the football field.
Enter the furthest southern driveway entrance.

From the East (US 136):

At the 3rd stoplight coming in from US 136 east, turn left (South) onto Dudley Street (Walgreen's/County Market).
Turn right at the stop sign at the intersection of Grant Street and Dudley Street.
Continue on Grant Street.
Turn left at the stop sign at the intersection of S. Johnson and Grant Street.
Macomb Senior High School will be on the left just past the football field.
Enter the furthest southern driveway entrance.

From the South (US 67):

Merge onto US 136 and at the 3rd stoplight coming in from US 136 east turn left onto Dudley Street (Walgreen's/County Market).
Continue (South) to the stop sign at the intersection of Grant and Dudley Street. Turn right.
Continue on Grant Street.
Turn left at the stop sign at the intersection of S. Johnson and Grant Street.
Macomb Senior High School will be on the left just past the football field.
Enter the furthest southern driveway entrance.
