Figure 3. 4-Year and 6-Year Graduation Rates of New Full-Time Freshmen by Sex Fall 2011 Cohort

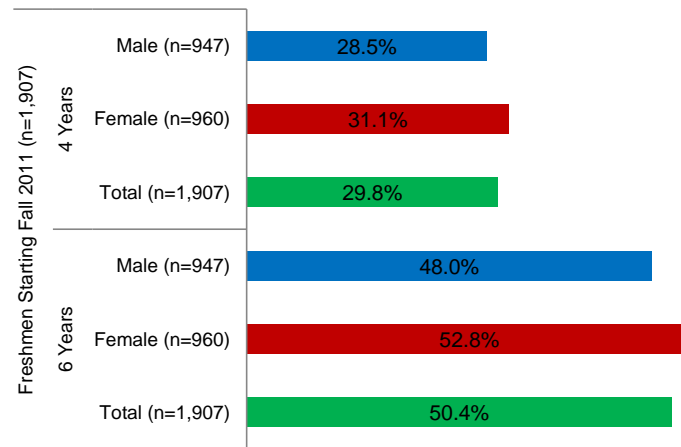
