Re: October 2018 Strategic Plan Update

This month's *Strategic Plan Update* provides you with the membership (see Table 1), fall meeting schedule (see Table 2), process, and planned deliverables from the Social Responsibility Planning Task Force (SRTF) during academic year 2018-2019.

The SRTF is charged with reviewing the Higher Learning Commission's Criteria for Accreditation, as the University prepares for reaffirmation of accreditation from the Commission. The University's onsite visits will occur on the Quad Cities campus during academic year 2019-2020 and on the Macomb campus during academic year 2020-2021.

The SRTF will review the five criteria for accreditation and all of the core components to ensure that Western complies with the Commission's expectations. Areas in need of additional efforts and opportunities resulting from the review will be translated into the University's Academic Year 2019-2020 Strategic Plan Supplement. This process provides evidence that the University engages in continuous improvement.

Following institutional planning precedent, development of the Strategic Plan Supplement will be an iterative process with the University community. This will culminate in receiving endorsement from all governance groups on both campuses before seeking implementation approval from the Western Illinois University Board of Trustees.

As SRTF materials are shared with the University community, please contact me or any member of the SRTF if you have questions, concerns, recommendations, and/or other feedback. Together, we will produce a strong, empirically-based review of Western's status on the accreditation criteria and a resultant Strategic Plan Supplement. Likewise, please contact me if you have any questions about the material presented in this *Update*, and/or feedback for the continued successful implementation of *Higher Values in Higher Education*.
