Riverfront construction completed during the past 30 days

Construction completed in the last 30 days includes installation of :

- tube steel at 1st floor
- exterior and interior wall framing at 1st floor
- 1st floor sheathing
- brick and concrete block for the building exterior
- precast concrete walls
- an initial course of asphalt for the parking lot
- additional concrete grade beams for west building addition
- drywall at 2nd floor
- steel columns/beams/joists
- door frames and borrow lights at 1st floor
- mechanical/electrical/plum bing rough-ins at 1st floor.





(The future River Tech Boulevard will run along the southern perimeter of the Riverfront Campus. The road will provide additional access to the campus area. The City of Moline obtained federal funding to make the road way available.)

Construction activities in the next 30 days

Construction activities slated for the next 30 days include:

- continue cold weather masonry installation
- cold weather slab installation at west and north building additions



- continue structural steel installation
- first floor exterior wall and insulation installation
 - light pole installation
 - continue

mechanical/electrical/plumbing service installations

- application of fluid applied air barrier
- installation of geothermal well fields will also continue.
