<ol> <li>I have completed at least three semesters of college course work.</li> <li>I have completed at least 18 credit hours of college-level Spanish or the equivalent.<sup>2</sup></li> <li>I have completed or am currently enrolled in at least one course at the 300-level or higher in Hispanic literature (e.g., SPAN 327, 328, etc.) or Hispanic culture (i.e., SPAN 408 or 409).</li> <li>I have a cumulative grade point average of 3.2 or better in all college courses completed.</li> <li>I have a grade point average of 3.0 or better in all Spanish courses completed.</li> </ol>
<ol> <li>attend a mandatory initiation ceremony; date (during either the last week of April or first week of May) and time TBD</li> <li>pay a one time fee of \$40,3 which covers the dues to the national chapter; this fee will be forfeited if you are unable to attend the initiation; do not pay until after receiving letter of acceptance</li> <li>actively contribute to the honor society by participating in programs that help our mission of promoting and spreading the Spanish language and Hispanic cultures</li> </ol>
