Scholarships

Materials submitted should include:

1. Completed application form (PART I) Must be completed on the computer or typed —handwritten applications will not be considered.
2. On separate paper, in a narrative form, use headings below to address the following: (All components must be included for consideration.)
 - **Background.**
 - Briefly described personal history.
 - Include information about educational experiences and events that led to your decision to choose your specific major and
 - why you are applying for this scholarship (financial need).
 - **Awards and Honors received in college.**
 - **Service/Leadership Activities.** Describe degree of involvement in extra-curricular, civic or community activities.
 - **Potential contribution to teaching profession.** Describe your approach to working with students including specific teaching/career goals.
 - **NOTE: The following require an additional separate essay:**
The Ada Drake scholarship requires a separate essay of academic interests, activities, work experience and plans for the future. The Ernest Paul Lambert Memorial Scholarship requires an essay on why the candidate wants to be a teacher and what are his/her career goals. The Western High Scholarship requires a one page essay describing applicant's intent to “pay it forward” (give back to the profession as an educator).
3. Two letter(s) of recommendations from WIU faculty attesting to the quality of the applicant's academic performance and promise as an educator.
4. Copy of most current WIU transcript (www.wiu.edu/Registrar/forms) sent to CPEP Scholarships, Horrabin Hall 91.
5. Financial Need form

Applications are due on or before April 1 and should be forwarded to the Scholarship Committee, Center for the Preparation of Education Professionals, Horrabin Hall 91, Western Illinois University, 1 University Circle, Macomb, IL 61455.

Selection: The recipients will be selected by the CPEP Scholarship Committee with its recommendations provided to the University Scholarship Office. Recipients will be announced by the first of May and recognized at the WIU Foundation Scholars' Recognition Ceremony in the fall.

This application is set up in PDF format. Enter appropriate information in text box provided. Use TAB or mouse to move from text box to text box. The size of the text box determines the amount of information that can be included. **Handwritten applications will not be considered.**
