The position requires the successful completion of 900 hours (approximately 20 hours/week) of service. The member will receive a monthly living allowance of \$504. Additionally, an education award of \$2,775 is available at the successful completion of the term.

We are seeking a motivated, out-going person with a background in natural resources, biology, parks and recreation, or in community organizing, administration, or communications. The person must have strong communication skills and a desire to work with diverse groups of people. Work hours will be days, Monday through Friday, and occasional nights and weekends. This is an excellent opportunity for an individual to gain valuable experience in education and conservation.

- Recruiting and training volunteers
