

## PAINTING STUDIO

# Safety Regulations

1. Do not smoke or eat in the studio.
2. **NEVER** work in studio while under the influence of alcohol or narcotics.
3. Be aware of the location of fire extinguishers and how to use them.
4. **NEVER** leave solvent soaked rags lying around the studio. Place all solvent-soaked rags and paper in self-closing, fire-safe waste cans.
5. Store flammable materials in the flammable-storage cabinet with a safety label identifying the substance.
6. Keep all chemical containers closed when they are not in use.
7. Clean up all spills immediately!!!
8. Perform spray applications in a paint-spray booth. Choose brushing techniques rather than spray applications if possible.
9. Never wash your hands in a solvent.
10. Wear chemical protective gloves, apron, and eye protection (goggles) as necessary when handling solvents and corrosive chemicals, or when cleaning brushes and other equipment.
11. Use barrier creams/skin moisturizers to prevent casual contact with solvents/toxins.
12. Do not hold your brush handle with your teeth.
13. Wash your hands thoroughly when you finish working or leave the studio.
14. If you are the last person to leave the studio make sure the parts washer and all lights are turned OFF before leaving the studio.
15. Report all injuries **IMMEDIATELY!**
