The ensemble audition will take place during the **first week** of classes in the spring semester 2021. The time and location will be posted during the week **before** classes begin. You will prepare the following:


- 1. **B Major Scale:** in three octaves, <u>from low B</u>, **slurred** ascending and *portato* descending. Play in the fastest tempo you can play securely and evenly. Tempo suggestion: quarter note = 60-80 (grouped in 16th notes).
- 2. **Bizet: from the opera Carmen, the entr'acte.** Make sure you listen to recordings of this excerpt to understand its character and tempo.
- 3. **Dukas: from the Sorcerer's Apprentice**. Make sure you listen to recordings of this excerpt to understand its character and tempo.
- 4. **Sibelius: from Symphony #2, movement 1.** Make sure you listen to recordings of this excerpt to understand its character and tempo.
- 5. **Donizetti: from the opera L'Elisir D'amore, Una Furtiva Lacrima.** Make sure you listen to recordings of this excerpt to understand its character and tempo.

Record yourself and pay close attention to rhythm, tempo, pitch, and phrasing!
