was a regular supporter and participant at events at the  
School of Music at Western Illinois University—including  
the WESTERN ILLINOIS HORN FESTIVAL. A detailed

## Application procedures.

A. Prepare and submit a recording on compact disc# of the following Repertoire:

1. One Solo from the following list: *A movement from:*

- **One of the Horn Concerti by W.A. Mozart,**
- ***Concerto No.1 or No. 2* by Richard Strauss,**
- ***The Horn Concerto* by Gliere *Or one of the following solos:***
- **Paul Dukas: *Villanelle***
- **Louis Piantoni: *Air de Chasse***
- **Camille Saint-Saëns: *Romance op. 36***
- **Camille Saint-Saëns: *Morceau de Concert***
- **Gilbert Vinter: *Hunter's Moon***
- **Randall Faust: *Rondo in E-flat (in honor of Roger Collins)***

### Plus

- 2. The Horn Solo (Andante Cantabile) from the Second Movement from *Symphony No. 5* by Tchaikovsky. (This passage is available in many Books of orchestral studies—such as those by David Thompson, Richard Moore, and Arthur Labar)-- as well as Darren Robbins' Horn Excerpt Anthology on the website:
