

FY24 Benefit Choice Open Enrollment Period

Benefit Choice Period: May 1, 2023 – May 31, 2023

Effective July 1, 2023

Changes for FY24

There will be no changes to premiums this year, however it is encouraged for you to review your elections and FY24 Benefit Choice booklet to understand the coverage you have on your current plan or if you wish to change plans, be able to review the options available to you.

MCAP/DCAP/HSA

MCAP (Medical Care Assistance Plan): The Unused rollover of FY23 funds is capped at \$570. *(this means if you have more than \$570 in your HSA account, and you don't use it prior to the end of FY23, any amount over the \$570 limit will be forfeited.)* **Participants who do not re-enroll for the new plan year will forfeit any amount eligible for rollover.**

The MCAP Maximum contribution limit for FY24 is \$3,050. The rollover of unused FY24 funds will be capped at \$610

DCAP (Dependent Care Assistance Plan): The FY24 limit for DCAP is \$5,000. Any Unused DCAP funds at the end of the plan year will be forfeited.

HSA (Health Savings Account): *(Only for employees enrolled in the Consumer Driven Health Plan or Quality Care Health Plans)*

Members enrolled in CDHP or QCHP HSA account will automatically be re-enrolled for the employer contributions each year, but Members must elect to make their employee contributions for the next plan year.

YOU CANNOT BE ENROLLED IN BOTH HSA AND MCAP FLEX SPENDING ACCOUNT

In Person Open Enrollment Fairs
