# Illinois Documents

Illinois Documents are arranged using an adapted Dewey decimal alphanumeric system. Numbers are decimals.

Examples:

ILLINOIS 631.8 FARM

ILLINOIS 331.252 I29r 1989

Federal publications are shelved by executive office, agency, or congressional committee, instead of by subject. They are classified using the Superintendent of Documents call number system (SuDoc for short), an alphanumeric system where all numbers are whole numbers (not decimals!) separated by punctuation, including periods, slashes, dashes, and *always* a colon.

Examples:  
D 301.82/7:K 96  
Y 4.ED 8/1:104-21  
Y 3.AT 7:22/WASH-1184
