**OTHER REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCEPTANCE  
TO THE SCHOOL OF MUSIC:**

A statement of your personal goals, official transcripts, and three letters of recommendation from teachers who know your work, will also need to be submitted to Graduate Studies (or International Studies). Copies of those documents must be received by the School of Music, for consideration of your application to the Graduate music program.

Assistantships are available only to graduate students who have been accepted into degree programs. Probationary students are not eligible to hold graduate assistantships. The assistantship application is available online and can be electronically submitted at the same time as the application, to Graduate Studies. The Graduate Office provides an electronic copy of all documents, including transcripts, to the School of Music.

Assistantship applications received in the Graduate Studies Office prior to **March 15** (for Fall Semester) may be given priority consideration.

Graduate assistantships may be limited because of the number of returning grads who are in the second year of their assistantship. Please let the School of Music know if you plan to apply for a Graduate Assistantship and/or wish to be considered for other award(s) by marking one of the answers below:
