

GENERAL INFORMATION

Registration: Enrollment is limited to 20 students who are admitted on a first-come, first-served basis. **The full \$325 commuter** registration fee includes all program costs. Registration forms, with payment information, can be completed online at www.wiu.edu/summeryouth, mailed to Study Abroad & Outreach, Horrabin Hall 8, Western Illinois University, 1 University Circle, Macomb, IL 61455, or faxed to (309) 298-2226. Checks are to be made payable to Western Illinois University.

Pricing and Payment Assistance: Register before March 15, 2018 & receive a 10% Early Bird Discount off the **\$325 commuter** registration cost. Registration includes all program costs. Payment Plan and Scholarship information is available by contacting our office. We also will offer an **additional 10% discount** to families who send more than one child to a camp or enroll one child for multiple camps. Parents who wish to use a Payment Plan may send a \$100 deposit at the time of registration. Full payment is due 30 days before the start of the program.

Refund Policy: WIU reserves the right to withdraw a program because of unforeseen circumstances or insufficient enrollment. If a program is

withdrawn, participants will be notified and fees will be refunded. A \$50 fee will be charged to participants who cancel after Monday, June 25, 2018. **No refunds will be made on or after Monday, July 2, 2018.**

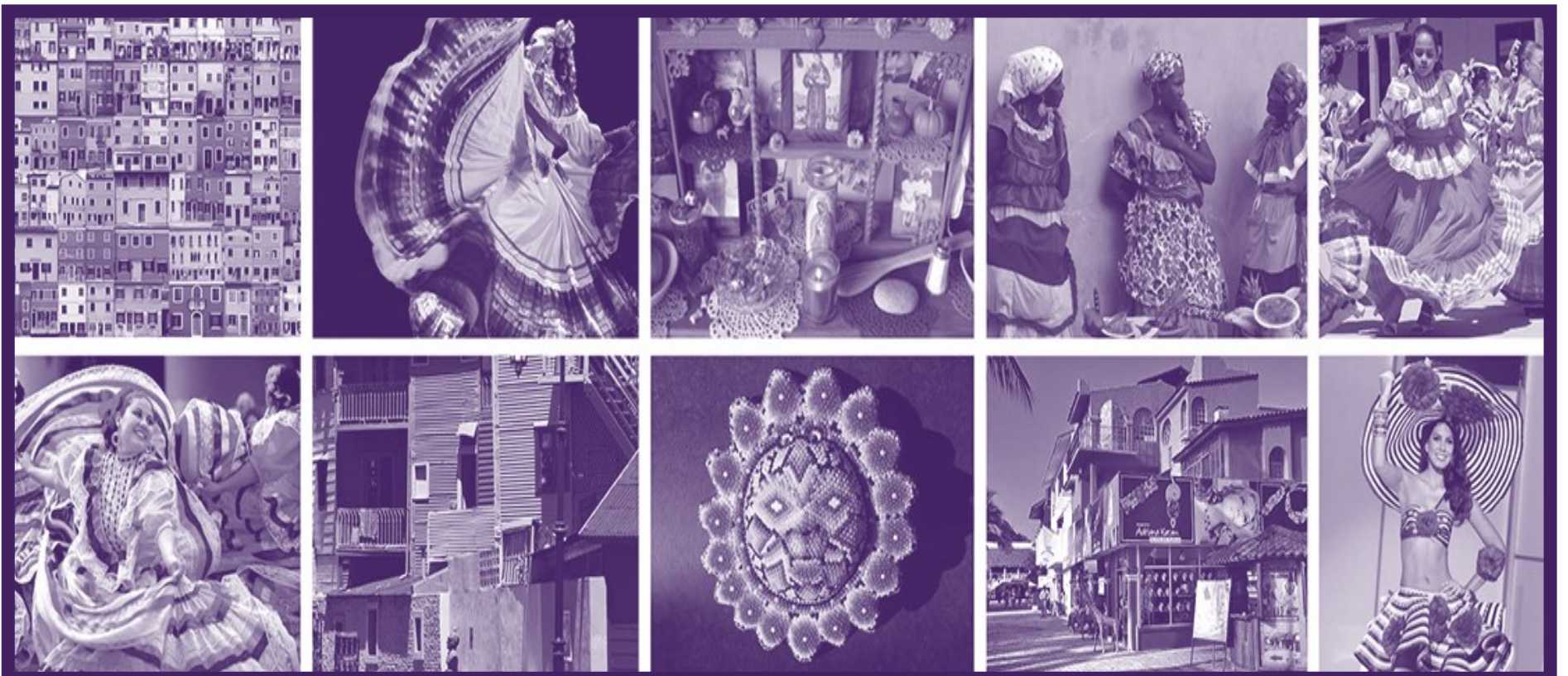

Program Description

Do you wish to expand your Spanish speaking skill while also embarking on a journey through? Study Spanish through core activities teaching about traditional Latin history, sports, music, and dance. Learn to speak Spanish from native speakers, and learn Latin cooking. How about learning how to dance salsa? This summer students can immerse themselves in a culture different from their own. For five days, **seventh through eleventh graders** can take a journey to Latin America.

Topics will include:

Foreign Language: Students will learn basic Spanish in a variety of interactive learning activities that will integrate foreign language.

Geography: Students will get a sense of the landscape, weather conditions, animal species, and living condition through a direct geographical perspective.

Music: Students will embark on an opportunity to listen to music, old and current, from Latin countries. As well as master dances taught by Salsa dancing professionals.

Sports: Experts fluent in playing soccer and baseball will talk about the significance of these two sports in Latin culture. Students will play each sport once a day.

Cooking/Art: Students will make real life– like passports to grant entry into each country each day along with creating currency to be converted for use. They will also have the opportunity to make and take home sports jersey from famous baseball and soccer teams.

Participation Criteria

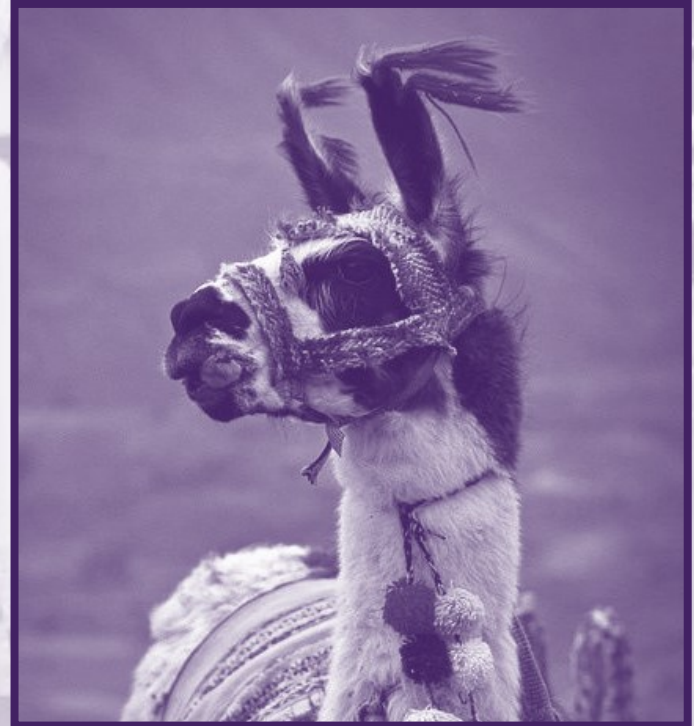
Program is open to students in grades seventh through eleventh who are admitted on a first-come, first-served basis. Enrollment is limited to 20 students, so please register early.
