

THE CHARLES C. GILBERT SCHOLARSHIP TRUST

ELIGIBILITY:

The Scholarships will be available to sophomore, junior and senior level students (minimum of 30 semester hours earned upon receiving this award) enrolled full-time (minimum 12 semester hours), at Western Illinois University. In addition, the recipients must be active members (at least one year) of the Iota Omicron Chapter of Sigma Chi Fraternity on the campus of Western Illinois University.

CRITERIA:

The primary purpose of the award is to recognize those undergraduate members of the Fraternity who best exemplify those character traits encouraged in the "Jordan Standard" of the Sigma Chi Fraternity. Principle offices of the Chapter are eligible but holding and elective leadership position is not the primary criteria for the award.

Evidence of involvement in campus activities, fraternity public services or philanthropic projects, and other chapter activities, especially in a leadership capacity will be considered in making the selection of the recipient.

Applicants must be in good academic standing and have earned a cumulative grade point average of 2.25 or better.

Financial need of the applicants may be considered.

SELECTION:

An application or letter of nomination, and all supporting documents should be submitted to the Chapter Advisor. The selection of the recipient(s) will be by a committee comprised of representatives from the Sigma Chi House Corporation Board, the Executive Committee of the Iota Omicron Chapter, the Chapter Advisor, the local Sigma Chi Alumni organization if and when it formed, and the Student Activities Director or his/her designee.

TERMS:

The amount of the award(s) shall be equal to, but not greater than, one-half cost of tuition and fees for a student(s) for one year.
