The 2+2 is a four-year plan that leads to a Bachelor of Science degree in Psychology at Western Illinois University (WIU).

Students intending to complete a Bachelor of Science (B.S) degree in Psychology from WIU should follow the Associate in Science (A.S.) degree program outlined in this brochure from Carl Sandburg College (CSC).

Students who complete the A.S. degree at Carl Sandburg College may transfer to WIU and complete their B.S. degree in Psychology in an additional two years.

Notes for CSC

1. Social Science electives need to be from two disciplines other than Psychology (ECO, GEO, POS, SOC)
2. No more than two courses from the same discipline may be counted toward fulfillment of the Humanities General Education category at WIU
3. No more than two courses from the same discipline may be counted toward fulfillment of the Natural Sciences/Mathematics General Education category at WIU
4. Both Psy221 and Psy265 at CSC are equivalent to Psy221 at WIU. If both are taken, student will earn Psy Elective credit for one of the courses.
