The Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) is the professional arts degree, with a focus on intensive work in art and design, supported by a program of general studies. The BFA major consists of at least 80 credits within the department.

- The 2+2 is a four-year plan that leads to a BFA in Art (Studio) Option degree at WIU.
- The AFA in Art at McHenry County College (MCC) provides preparation for students planning to pursue the BFA in Art at WIU.

- Students are strongly encouraged to contact WIU prior to their sophomore year for specific admission advice.
- For the science AFA requirement at MCC, students must complete both a Life and a Physical Science course, 1 of which must include a lab.
- Students must receive a grade of C or higher in ENG 151 and ENG 152 at MCC.
- For the social and behavioral science AFA requirement at MCC, courses from at least 2 separate disciplines should be taken.

Notes for WIU

- An Entry Portfolio Review course (ARTS 210), and a minimum 2.50 GPA in Art is required for admission to the BFA major. (*Transfer students are encouraged to enroll in ARTS 210 during the first semester at WIU*).
- Students must consult with their advisor at least once each semester.
- Students are advised to consider taking Summer courses that meet requirements.
- All BFA students are required to develop a quality body of art, or portfolio that represents their achievement as professionally focused BFA students.
- To strengthen their portfolios, students **can** take additional art courses at MCC or WIU. These courses will not be listed as part of this 2+2 Agreement, and may delay the time to degree completion.
- All graduating BFA students are required to participate in a Senior exhibition.
