The 2+2 is a four-year plan that leads to a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing at WIU.

Students intending to complete a baccalaureate degree in nursing from WIU should follow the Associate in Science in Nursing degree program outlined in this brochure from Carl Sandburg College.

Students who complete the ADN degree at Carl Sandburg may transfer to WIU and complete their B.S.N. degree in an additional 2 years.

- Fulltime scheduling preferred, but not mandatory; student can attend on a part-time basis.
- All clinicals are project based.
- CHEM 102 is waived.
