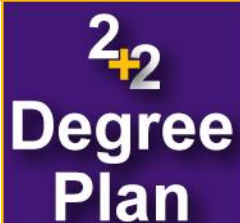

The 2+2 is a four-year plan that leads to a Bachelor of Science degree in RPTA at WIU.

Students intending to complete a baccalaureate degree in RPTA from WIU should follow the Associate in Parks and Natural Resources degree program outlined in this brochure from Kirkwood Community College.

Students who complete the Parks and Natural Resources Associates degree may transfer to WIU-Quad Cities and complete their degree in RPTA with a Minor in Environmental Studies in an additional two years.
