 - We kicked off the Application Status Custom Portal implementation project with Carnegie Underscore on 10/2/2023. Carnegie will help us to build our student application portal within Slate.
 - Regent Education Financial Aid Software
 - Regent Education won the bid for the Financial Aid software implementation.
 - We are currently reviewing the Statement of Work and Master Service Agreement.
 - We hope to have a project kickoff mid-October. Our goal is to have phase 1 implemented by April 1st so that we can receive ISIR records, perform verification and process award letters.
 - Ellucian Colleague
 - The University is hoping to move forward with the purchase of the Ellucian Colleague ERP system. This system will completely replace our existing homegrown MVS/WIUP system and will contain modules for Finance, Human Resources and Student Information System (SIS). The Administration is currently evaluating financing options for the annual subscription and implementation cost.
