Dr. LaPrad is the Director of the School of Education and a Professor of Philosophical and Social Foundations of Education at Western Illinois University, teaching courses in the social foundations of education from philosophical, historical, legal, and socio-cultural perspectives to teacher candidates, in-service teachers, and educational leaders. His research, scholarship and practice include critical pedagogy in teaching and learning environments, experiential education, educational ethics, multicultural education, transformative educational leadership and P-12 educational reform. He is a former high school and middle school teacher, Outward Bound instructor and big brother with Big Brothers and Big Sisters. He served 3 terms on the Macomb Community Unit School District #185 Board of Education from 2012 to 2024.
