

## Example of Impact

### **College Level Service Activities:**

I served the college by assisting during the SOAR (summer orientation and registration) program. In my position as Director of the athletic training program, I receive reassigned ACEs to be the academic advisor for the athletic training students, but am not required to participate in the summer SOAR Program. I felt strongly about learning this aspect of advising in order to be of better service to the prospective students that I often communicate with throughout the year. So I have volunteered my time to participate in the SOAR program and help the college advisors register new students.

**\*Impact:** The impact here is the idea that many hands make light work. The Kinesiology department often has a large volume of students that attend SOAR. Therefore, my volunteering to help answer questions about the major and general education courses makes the day go faster for the advisors and helps the students make appropriate choices. This is especially true in the late summer sessions, when many of the courses are closed and the choices are limited.
