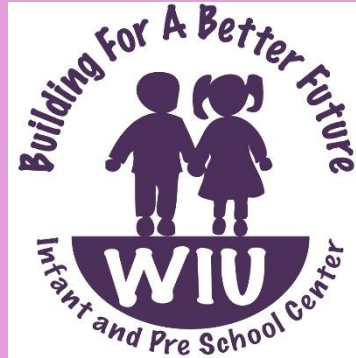

Exploring Bubble Wrap and Paint

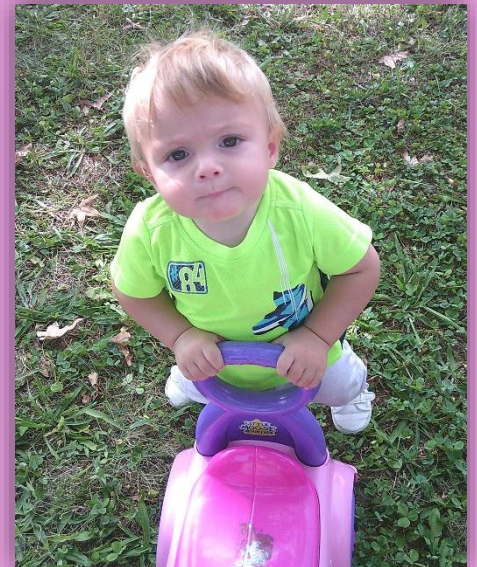
Standard: Children demonstrate the ability to coordinate their small muscles in order to move and control objects.

Squishing, Squashing, and Rolling our Play Dough



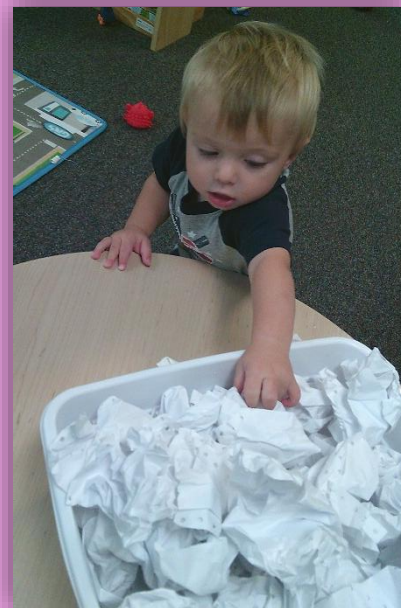
Standard: Children demonstrate strength, coordination, and controlled use of large muscles.
