 - Early Childhood majors: 2.0
 - AgEd, Art, Elementary, English, English as a Second Language Education, French, Mathematics, Middle School, Multilingual, Music, Physical Education, Science/Biology- Chemistry-Physics, Spanish, and Special Education majors: 2.5
 - History majors: 2.75
- Complete and submit a Reflective Paper, which was positively evaluated by the major department.
