- Brian Locke updated the committee on the recent conversation with the Council on General Education (CGE) regarding the Multicultural Perspectives graduation form.
  - Comments from Annette Hamm:
    - The Multicultural Studies and Human Well-Being categories of General Education have been eliminated.
    - The Foreign Language/Global Issues (FLGI) requirement has also been eliminated and will be replaced by a Multicultural Perspectives graduation requirement.
    - To initiate the new requirement, the Provost's Office has allowed existing Discipline-Specific Global Issues and General Education Multicultural Studies courses to automatically transition to fulfill the new requirement.

  - Comments from Amy Carr, Chair of CGE
    - There hadn't been an awareness that CGE had historically been responsible for determining which courses were considered Multicultural (which was different from the designation regarding Foreign Languages and Global Issues--even though some courses could count in either category).
