Council on Curricular Programs and Instruction

The Council on Curricular Programs and Instruction (CCPI) met approximately every other Thursday during the fall and spring semesters (seven meetings per semester). Members of the council included Steve Bennett, Chair (Earth, Atmospheric & GIS); Bob Intrieri, Vice-Chair (Psychology); Eun Go, Secretary (Broadcasting and Journalism); Barry Birnbaum (Education); Niyazi Ekici (Law Enforcement and Justice Administration); Leaunda Hemphill (Engineering Technology); Hadley Kaminga-Peck (Theatre & Dance); Jessica Lin (Economics and Decision Sciences); Elgin Mannion (Sociology and Anthropology); Sebastian Syzjka (Curriculum and Instruction); Ryan Homer (SGA Representative).

Ex-officio members of the council were Mark Mossman, Interim Associate Provost; and Donna Williams from the Registrar's Office. Additional representation from the Provost's Office was provided by Linda Prosis. Annette Hamm (Faculty Senate Office) took minutes of each meeting and coordinated the work of CCPI.

The bulk of the work of CCPI during 2019-2020 consisted of the first itemized duty assigned to it, which is the recommendation to the Faculty Senate for approval or disapproval of all new academic programs and courses along with changes to existing courses which affect catalog copy. CCPI considered the requests on the attached chart.

One new major was approved by CCPI:

1. Educational Studies (School of Education)

Ten new minors were approved by CCPI:

1. Educational Studies (School of Education)
2. Cannabis Production (School of Agriculture)
3. Cannabis and Culture (Interdisciplinary)
4. Emergency Management - Operational (for non-EM Majors) (School of Law Enforcement and Justice Administration)
5. Emergency Management - Tactical (for non-EM Majors) (School of Law Enforcement and Justice Administration)
6. Emergency Management - Operational (for EM Majors) (School of Law Enforcement and Justice Administration)
7. Emergency Management - Tactical (for EM Majors) (School of Law Enforcement and Justice Administration)
8. American Sign Language (ASL) (Dept. of Speech Pathology and Audiology)
9. Youth Leadership (Dept. of Recreation, Park and Tourism Administration)
10. Computer Science Education (School of Computer Science)

Three new options were approved by CCPI:

1. Mathematics: Actuarial Science (Dept. of Mathematics and Philosophy)
2. Applied Meteorology
3. Operational Meteorology

Two new emphases were approved by CCPI:

1. Accountancy: Management Accounting (Dept. of Accounting and Finance)
2. Accountancy: Taxation (Dept. of Accounting and Finance)

Additionally, CCPI offered a Curriculum Workshop on September 19, 2019. The workshop provided guidance for faculty and administrators on the proper procedures for submitting curricular changes to CCPI. It was presented by 2018-19 CCPI Chair Anita Hardeman and both the PowerPoint presentation and a video of the presentation are posted on the CCPI page of the Faculty Senate web site.
