

Post-Baccalaureate Certificate in Health Services Administration



The Western Illinois University Department of Health Sciences and Social Work provides a Post-Baccalaureate Certificate in Health Services Administration, which is available online. The certificate program consists of coursework needed for professionals in health services administration. The focus of the program is to provide students with a basic knowledge of health services organizational behavior and leadership, administration and management, legal aspects of health administration and U.S. health policy.

Benefits of the Certificate

Students who have completed the certificate program are prepared to become medical and health services managers.

Admission Criteria

An overall grade point average of 2.75, or a GPA of 3.00 or higher for the last two years of undergraduate work, is required for admission into the program.

- HSM 515 Legal Aspects of Health Services Management (3 SH)

- HSM 516 Introduction to U.S. Health Policy (3 SH)
- HSM 517 Health Services Organization Behavior and Leadership (3 SH)
- EM 561 Foundations of Emergency Management (3 SH)
- EM 565 Evacuation Planning and Response (3 SH)

Total: 18 SH

In order to complete the certificate, a student must earn a cumulative GPA of 3.0 for all required classes.
