## FROM THE ILLINOIS LABOR RELATIONS BOARD

### STIPULATION AND NOTICE OF UNIT CLARIFICATION PETITION

The employer, **Western Illinois University**, and exclusive representative, **Illinois Fraternal Order of Police Labor Council**, have stipulated to an amendment or clarification of an existing bargaining unit as indicated below. If no objections are filed pursuant to this notice, a Certification of Unit Clarification will be issued by the Illinois Labor Relations Board.

NO DETERMINATION HAS BEEN MADE AT THIS TIME by the Illinois Labor Relations Board.

Your employer is posting this notice for at least 20 days so that the Illinois Labor Relations Board can inform you of your basic rights under the Illinois Public Labor Relations Act.

The stipulated clarification is to REVISE the following titles in the existing S-UC-(S)-26-013 bargaining unit:

**To update the titles in the certification to reflect the current titles used by the State Universities Civil Service System office. The proposed clarification to the existing unit is as follows:**

**INCLUDED: All personnel in full-time, probationary or status positions in the Civil Service Merit Board classifications of Police Telecommunicator, Police Officer, Police Corporal, and Police Sergeant.**

**EXCLUDED: All supervisory, managerial, and confidential employees as defined by the Illinois Public Labor Relations Act and all other employees of the University including all full-time and part-time administrative, professional and Civil Service Employees.**

### Existing Unit Description:

Included: All personnel in full-time, probationary or status positions in the Civil Service Merit Board classifications of Police Telecommunicator, Police I, Police Officer II, and Police Sergeants (Police Officer III).

Excluded: All supervisory, managerial, and confidential employees as defined by the Illinois Public Labor Relations Act and all other employees of the University including all full-time and part-time administrative, professional and Civil Service Employees.

Any interested person may file objections to the above stipulation with the Board in accordance with the applicable Rules and Regulations of the Illinois Labor Relations Board. Such objections shall be served on the employer and the exclusive representative prior to, or simultaneously with, their filing.
