## ***School of Music Scholarships***

### **The Blyler Award for Musical Excellence**

Awarded to a student who has been in the School of Music two years and who displays a professional attitude towards music through performance and service.

### **The Walter H. Eller Music Scholarship**

Presented annually to a junior member of the WIU Bands.

### **The Dr. A. Oren Gould Scholarship**

Awarded to a junior music major in instrumental music education.

### **The Clifford A. and Rosa Julstrom Scholarship**

Applicants for this award must be juniors who are full-time students and majors in string music.

### **The Roscoe G. Linder Band Scholarship**

Persons selected for this scholarship should be at least a second year band member in good standing and should be able to demonstrate dependability, leadership qualities, and service.

### **The Hugo Magliocco Trombone Scholarship**

The recipient of this award must be an international student or an African-American or Hispanic-American student entering the School of Music for the first time as a freshman or transfer student, and must win and maintain a talent grant award.

### **The Jane Lanier Synovitz Memorial Scholarship**

The recipient of this award must be a junior woman, outstanding vocalist, and music major.

### **The Wanninger Foundation Scholarship**

Scholarships are available to students whose educational careers were interrupted for at least two years and now have decided to continue their education, with an emphasis in vocal music.

### **Tom Wood Clarinet Scholarship**

Awarded to a clarinet student who is a music major.

### **The Ruby Miller Raglin Memorial Scholarship in Music**

The Ruby Miller Raglin Memorial Scholarship in Music was established in 1999 by the Orpha Raglin Welke Estate to provide scholarship assistance to outstanding students in music performance.

### **The Most Versatile Percussionist**

This award is offered each year to a qualified percussionist at WIU.

### **The Bruce Gardner Singer Scholarship**

The intent of this scholarship is to encourage the attraction, retention, and development of outstanding singers in the WIU School of Music.

### **The Shanklin Scholarship**

The Shanklin Scholarship was recently established to honor Grant and Kathryn Shanklin, who were both active in the Macomb community throughout their lives.

### **The Ann Collins Jazz Piano Scholarship**

The Ann Collins Scholarship, established by Ann and Rex Collins of Macomb, will be awarded to a student who demonstrates significant musical talent in jazz piano performance.

### **The Rhoda Butler Collaborative Piano Scholarship**

The Butler Scholarship is open to all student accompanists in the School of Music who have demonstrated a record of active and outstanding work as an accompanist.

**Bessie Myers Scholarship**

Presented to a music major based on financial need and capability and proficiency in performance.

**Lillian Ruth Roberts Scholarship in Piano or Voice**

Awarded to a freshmen female music major based on merit and potential.

**Lillian Ruth Roberts Scholarship in Strings**

Awarded to a music major who participates in ensembles.

**James Magsig Collaborative Piano Scholarship**

Presented to a music major or minor who demonstrate outstanding work as an accompanist, either in the School of Music or for entering students, in the student's prior experience.

**Laura Beu Scholarship**

Awarded to a sophomore, junior or senior with a minimum GPA of 3.0.

**Dale Hopper Jazz Studies Scholarship**

Awarded to a student exhibiting interest and talent in jazz performance and excellent service to WIU jazz ensembles and demonstrating significant talent.

**The Violet Poppleton Scholarship**

Awarded to a female vocal music major.

**The Claudia McCain Music Business Scholarship**

Awarded to a music business major who is completing a music business internship.

**Dr. Forest D. Suycott, Jr. Scholarship**

Awarded to a student with a GPA of at least 3.0 who is an active participant in the ensemble program.

**Dr. Elizabeth Wehrman Music Education Scholarship**


