SUGGESTED ARRIVAL TIMES

Peak move-in times tend to be from 10_{AM} to 3_{PM}. We encourage you to use the recommended target times based on your home's proximity to campus to help distribute move-in traffic and reduce wait times. The times do not need to be strictly followed.

IF YOU LIVE WITHIN



0-75 miles from campus: Arrive 8:00ам - 9:00ам

76-125 miles from campus: Arrive 9:00am - 10:00am

126-150 miles from campus: Arrive 10:00am - 11:00am

151-175 miles from campus: Arrive 11:00am - NOON

176-200 miles from campus: Arrive Noon - 1:00рм

Over 200 miles from campus: Arrive after 1:00 PM


Frequently Asked Questions
