- Enrollment by location, sex, race/ethnicity, new student count, and second major.
- Degrees conferred by race/ethnicity.
- New freshmen profile (standardized test scores, high school rank, and high school grade point average).
- Fall enrollment at Illinois Public Universities for programs with the same six-digit Classification of Instructional Program (CIP) code.
- Fiscal year degrees conferred at Illinois Public Universities for programs with the same six-digit Classification of Instructional Program (CIP) code.
- Fiscal year cost per credit hour.
- Fiscal year credit hours per staff year.
