Dear FIELD(7):

I regret to inform you that you have been academically suspended from Western Illinois University for failure to meet established academic requirements as of the end of the 2025 Spring Semester. The Council on Admission, Graduation, and Academic Standards has reviewed your academic progress and determined that you are **not** eligible to enroll in WIU courses for the 2025 Fall Semester.

A review of your transcript indicates that you have:

- Attempted FIELD(8) semester hours at WIU.
- Earned FIELD(9) honor points.
- Earned a cumulative grade point average of FIELD(10).
- An honor point deficiency of FIELD(11).
- Received one academic suspension.

The honor point deficiency represents the number of semester hours of "B" (3.0) grades needed in order to raise your cumulative grade point average to 2.000 and good standing status, with no grades less than "C" (2.0). This calculation does not take into account the potential impact of repeating a course at WIU and replacing the previously earned grade under the Grade Replacement Policy.

As a result of your academic suspension, the following are applicable:

- 1. You have been deleted from all Summer and Fall classes for which you were registered.
- 2. If you were living in a residence hall, University Housing and Dining Services will contact you regarding your residence hall contract options.
- 3. The earliest semester for which you will be eligible to seek readmission is the 2026 Spring Semester.*

*Note: You may attend WIU for the 2025 Summer Session. If you achieve a cumulative grade point average of 2.000 or higher at the end of the Summer Session, you will be academically eligible to continue for Fall. If you do not achieve good academic standing at the end of the Summer Session, you will not be eligible to return for the 2025 Fall Semester, but will be allowed to return for the 2026 Spring Semester by following the reentry procedure stated below.

If you decide to seek reentry to WIU following the one semester suspension, you need to contact the General Studies Degree Program at bgs@wiu.edu to reactivate your records two months prior to the start of the term for which you are seeking to reenroll. If you attend another college or university during any term you are away from WIU, you must send an official transcript reflecting all credits and grades earned to the General Studies Degree Program. Grades from other colleges/universities will not raise your grade point average at WIU.
