Dear FIELD(7):

I regret to inform you that you have been academically dismissed from Western Illinois University for failure to meet established academic requirements as of the end of the 2025 Spring Semester. The Council on Admission, Graduation, and Academic Standards has reviewed your academic progress and determined that you are **not** eligible to enroll in WIU courses except for Summer Sessions only.

A review of your transcript indicates that you have:

- Attempted FIELD(8) semester hours at WIU.
- Earned FIELD(9) honor points.
- Earned a cumulative grade point average of FIELD(10).
- An honor point deficiency of FIELD(11).
- Received FIELD(12) academic dismissals.

The honor point deficiency represents the number of semester hours of "B" (3.0) grades needed in order to raise your cumulative grade point average to 2.000 and good standing status, with no grades less than "C" (2.0). This calculation does not take into account the potential impact of repeating a course at WIU and replacing the previously earned grade under the Grade Replacement Policy.

As a result of your academic dismissal, the following are applicable:

- 1. You have been deleted from all Summer and Fall classes for which you were registered.
- 2. If you were living in a residence hall, University Housing and Dining Services will contact you regarding your residence hall contract options.
- 3. You are eligible to attend WIU only during the Summer Sessions until you have achieved a cumulative grade point average of 2.000 or higher and good standing status.

If you decide to attend WIU for the 2025 Summer Session, you should consult with your academic advisor prior to registering for classes. If you achieve good academic standing based on your cumulative grade point average at the end of the Summer Session, you will be eligible to enroll in classes for the 2025 Fall Semester. If you do not raise your cumulative grade point average to 2.000 and good standing status, you will not be eligible to return to WIU until the 2026 Summer Session.

If you attend another college or university during any term you are away from WIU, you must send an official transcript reflecting all credits and grades earned to the General Studies Degree Program. Grades earned at other colleges/universities will not raise your WIU grade point average. Again, please consult your advisor before registering for any coursework.
