There will be an increase in the MAP funding for minority faculty at state universities. The bill to allow junior colleges to offer a four-year degree was not allowed. WIU was the most underfunded of all 12 state universities in a proposed formula. Federal work study program was eliminate. Pell grants may be eliminated International student numbers are lower than expected.
