	<b>Create an expandable college folder</b> where you can store all of your printed information, applications, and forms for future reference. Aren't sure if you'll need it? Save it!
	<ul> <li>Begin reviewing <i>University</i> scholarship opportunities available through the <u>WIU Scholarship Office</u> and WIU academic departments.</li> <li>→ Pay attention to application deadlines and requirements!</li> <li>→ Review tips on applying for WIU scholarships.</li> </ul>
	Begin researching <i>private</i> scholarship opportunities. Use reputable online scholarship searches like <a href="FastWeb">FastWeb</a> , CollegeIllinois!, and Scholarship Experts.  → Learn how to spot a scholarship scam  → Pay attention to deadlines and requirements!
	<ul> <li>Apply for your FSA ID and Password at <a href="www.fsaid.ed.gov">www.fsaid.ed.gov</a> to use when you complete your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) online.</li> <li>→ For <a href="students required to provide parent information">students required to provide parent information</a> on the FAFSA, your parent will also need to apply for an FSA ID and Password.</li> <li>Prepare to file your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) by reviewing our <a href="FAFSA">FAFSA</a> Completion HELP guide.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>File the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at <a href="www.fafsa.gov">www.fafsa.gov</a> to be considered for federal and state financial aid (it's a good idea to do this every year, even if you don't expect aid).</li> <li>→ File as soon as possible after October 1<sup>st</sup> – you may use estimated income information and then make corrections once your 2020 federal taxes are filed.</li> <li>→ Priority consideration is given to students who complete their FAFSA by February 1 – this helps to maximize a student's eligibility for certain campus and state funds, which are typically limited.</li> <li>→ Include WIU as a school you would like to have receive your FAFSA (school code 001780).</li> <li>→ If you would like your parent, spouse, etc. to have access to your financial aid information, set up a Parent/Guest Account on STARS.</li> </ul>
	<b>Review your Student Aid Report (SAR)</b> at <a href="www.fafsa.gov">www.fafsa.gov</a> for any mistakes or errors that need correcting.
	<ul> <li>Regularly check your WIU email and STARS/Financial Aid Information for any notifications or requests from our office.</li> <li>→ If you haven't already, activate your WIU email and STARS once you are accepted to the University.</li> <li>→ You may grant online access to your STARS records to a maximum of 5 guests by selecting Parent and Guest Account Management from STARS.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>IF SELECTED for Verification, submit the requested worksheet and additional requirements as instructed.</li> <li>→ You will receive an email notification if you have been selected for Verification – a STARS/Financial Aid Information message will also be posted.</li> <li>→ Please do not send a Verification Worksheet, tax returns, etc. unless the information is requested.</li> <li>→ Our goal is to review your information within 2-4 weeks after all requirements have been submitted. The</li> </ul>

volume of files and time of year will affect time needed for this review.

	<b>Continue to regularly check your WIU email</b> and <b>STARS/Financial Aid Information</b> frequently for reminders, requests, and notices from the Financial Aid Office.
	<ul> <li>Review your Financial Aid Award Offer on STARS/Financial Aid Information.</li> <li>→ You will be notified by email that your award letter has been completed and is available online.</li> <li>→ Estimate your expenses using the WIU Cost Estimator</li> <li>→ You may reduce or cancel your loans using STARS.</li> </ul>
	Start saving for upfront costs and personal expenses.  → Make the most of a summer job – save your earnings to purchase your textbooks!
	<b>Notify our office of any additional aid</b> you will receive that was not listed on your award letter.
	<b>Complete Entrance Counseling</b> at <a href="www.studentloans.gov">www.studentloans.gov</a> if this is your first time borrowing Federal Direct Student Loans.
	<b>Complete a Master Promissory Note</b> at <a href="www.studentloans.gov">www.studentloans.gov</a> if this is your first Federal Direct Student Loan, or if this is your first time borrowing student loan funds while attending WIU.
Now '	Γhat You're Enrolled
	<ul> <li>After registering for classes, calculate your expected charges using the WIU Cost Estimator.</li> <li>→ The first bills of the semester are usually sent during the first week of August and January.</li> <li>→ Student loans cannot be disbursed until immediately prior to the start of classes and will not appear on the August or January bills. Monitor your university account on STARS by selecting B/R Account Detail.</li> <li>→ Complete the Direct Deposit Authorization on STARS to receive any refund due you.</li> <li>→ Remember that funds are to be used only for educationally-related expenses such as books and supplies, room/board or rent, transportation to class, etc.</li> </ul>
	<b>Additional loan eligibility may be available</b> if needed. See <u>Parent PLUS loan</u> and <u>private alternative</u> <u>loan</u> information in the <u>Loans section</u> of our website.
	<ul> <li>Prepare to pay for your books by cash, check, or credit card.</li> <li>→ Books cannot be charged to your University account.</li> </ul>
	Read the Financial Aid Reminders available on our website.
	Read the Financial Aid Handbook & Policy Information available on our website.
	Review your federal student loan history at <a href="https://www.nslds.ed.gov">www.nslds.ed.gov</a> .  → Use every year to track your federal student loan debt – remember, borrow only what you need!  → Remember that private student loan information is not available through this federal database, so you will have to keep track of your private loan information yourself.
	<b>Get ready to do it all again</b> ! Financial aid is annual process, so there will be new scholarship applications every fall and a new FAFSA to complete every October.
	<ul> <li>Students who are graduating and/or not returning next year should:</li> <li>→ Complete Exit Counseling so they are aware of loan repayment procedures and obligations. A WIU email notification will be sent with Exit Counseling instructions.</li> <li>→ Review federal student loan history at <a href="www.nslds.ed.gov">www.nslds.ed.gov</a>.</li> <li>→ Learn about <a href="federal student loan consolidation">federal loan repayment options</a>.</li> </ul>
