- Process financial aid applications
  - » Federal/state grants
  - » Federal Work Study
  - » Federal loans
  - » Certain federal/state military programs
- Provide student employment support
- Provide financial literacy education on campus

**THE COST OF  
COLLEGE**

- Direct costs = billed by the school
- Generally includes:

Tuition	\$ 8,883.00
Fees	\$ 2,783.50
Room/Housing	\$ 9,800.00
One-Time Fees	\$ 115.00

---

**TOTAL = \$ 21,581.50**

- Individual costs are determined by individual decisions

- WIU Cost Estimator
  - » Online calculator to help provide a best-estimate of YOUR semester bill
- WIU Cost Guarantee
  - » Our students pay the same per credit hour rate for four straight years!
  - » Only Illinois university that “freezes” the per credit hour rate charged for *tuition and fees and room, and meal plan*

**FREE APPLICATION  
FOR FEDERAL

- FREE online at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov)
- Must be completed each year for the upcoming academic year
- Complete as soon as possible on or after **October 1** for 2020-21 school year
  - » *Tax information from 2018*



**FINANCIAL

PROCESS**

- Communication is key
- **WIU Email**
  - » Notifications
  - » Documentation requests
- **Student/Alumni Records System (STARS)**
  - » Application status
  - » Financial aid award letter
- Notifications are sent to the student

- Your *award letter* will list the financial aid available to you for each semester
  - » Available to view on STARS
  - » WIU email notification sent
  - » A copy will be mailed to home address
- Review directions
- Compare your financial aid to anticipated costs for each semester
- Notify our office of any enrollment changes, other expected aid, or special circumstances affecting your family
