

Scholarship Checklist for New Freshman Students

Accepted at WIU? Then you were automatically considered for the <u>Western Commitment Scholarship</u> , which is renewable up to four years!
 □ But don't forget - all other WIU scholarships require additional application. Beginning at the end of October you can apply for our new freshman scholarship opportunities using the WIU Scholarship Portal. → One general scholarship application for most new freshman scholarships. → Login using your WIU ECOM username and password. → 4.0+ GPA should submit by DECEMBER 15 for President's Scholarship consideration. Separate application is required for President's Scholarship. → All other new freshman scholarship applications due by MARCH 1.
File your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). Scholarships and financial aid go hand in hand – students should complete their FAFSA as soon as possible after October 1 at www.fafsa.gov . Have questions? Contact the WIU Financial Aid Office for assistance or to schedule an appointment!
Seek out local scholarship opportunities through community organizations, employers, etc.
 Search for private scholarship opportunities – get started by using our <u>Private Scholarships</u> postings. → Use reputable online scholarship searches like <u>FastWeb</u> and <u>CollegeIllinois!</u>. → Pay attention to deadlines and requirements!
If you are awarded a scholarship, you will be expected to complete a scholarship recipient profile. Additional details about this profile and process will be sent to you in an email during the fall semester.
low That You're Enrolled
 After registering for classes, calculate your expected charges using the WIU Cost Estimator. → The first bills of the semester are sent during the first week of August and January. → Most scholarships will display on your first billing statement. Monitor your day-to-day university account activity on STARS by selecting Financials > Account Detail and clicking "Account Details".
Complete the <u>Direct Deposit Authorization</u> on STARS if you anticipate a financial aid refund.
