

Scholarship Checklist for New Transfer Students

	Accepted at WIU? Then you were automatically considered for the Western Transfer Commitment Scholarship!
	But don't forget – all other WIU scholarships require additional application. Beginning at the end of October you can apply for our new transfer scholarship opportunities using the WIU Scholarship Portal. → One application for most new transfer scholarships. → Login using your WIU ECOM username and password. → New transfer applications due by MAY 1. → Department scholarship applications due by March 1.
	File your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). Scholarships and financial aid go hand in hand – students should complete their FAFSA as soon as possible after October 1 at www.fafsa.gov . Have questions? Contact the WIU Financial Aid Office for assistance or to schedule an appointment!
	Seek out local scholarship opportunities through community organizations, employers, etc.
	Seek out private scholarship opportunities – get started by using our <u>Private Scholarships</u> postings. → Use reputable online scholarship searches like <u>FastWeb</u> and <u>CollegeIllinois!</u> . → Pay attention to deadlines and requirements!
	If you are awarded a scholarship, you will be expected to complete a scholarship recipient profile. Additional details about this profile and process will be sent to you in an email during the fall semester.
Now	That You're Enrolled
	 After registering for classes, calculate your expected charges using the WIU Cost Estimator. → The first bills of the semester are sent during the first week of August and January. → Most scholarships will display on your first billing statement. Monitor your day-to-day university account activity on STARS by selecting Financials > Account Detail and clicking "Account Details".
	Complete the <u>Direct Deposit Authorization</u> on STARS if you anticipate a financial aid refund.
	Need to submit a scholarship check? Checks should be sent to or dropped off at the WIU Scholarship Office, Sherman Hall 303, 1 University Circle, Macomb, IL 61455 (M-F, 8:00 am – 4:30 pm).
