IF A STUDENT . . .

- Threatens to injure, harm, kill, or risk the safety of self or others
- Reports or initiates a campus threat
- Refuses to leave classroom/office/ building after being asked to leave

IF A STUDENT ...

- Behaves significantly out of character
- Behaves in a way that causes alarm
- Displays unhealthy or dangerous patterns of behavior



- Reports having been a victim of stalking, dating/domestic violence, or sexual assault
- Indicates experiencing hate crimes, bias, or discrimination
- Reports having been a victim of a crime
- · Reports having been subjected to hazing
- Exhibits behavior that deliberately interferes with instruction or office procedures

IF A STUDENT . . .

- **CONSULT FOR GUIDANCE OR ADVICE**
- Exhibits inappropriate behavior
- Reports feeling overwhelmed by family or personal emergency
- Seems overwhelmed by a problem that could affect University attendance
- Is not attending class for an extended period of time
- Having academic difficulty due to physical, physiological, or learning disability
- Indicates a need for disability accommodations

LEATHERNECK CARE REFERRAL

- Leatherneck Care Referral is an easy-to-use tool to share non-emergency-related concerns about student behaviors and potential barriers to success.
- If a concern involves an immediate safety risk to self or others, please call 911 or the Office of Public Safety at 309-298-1949. Leatherneck Care Referrals are for nonemergency-related concerns only.
- Once a student has been identified as needing support, appropriate staff will respond with an inclusive and suitable response to that particular concern and will connect with the individual to help resolve the issue.
- Staff will work to recognize and bridge the gap between poor academic performance, financial needs, social dysfunction, and emotional, behavioral, or medical issues.
