## Bachelor of Arts in Art/Master of Arts in Museum Studies 2 + 3

The 2+3 is a five-year integrated degree plan leading to the Bachelor of Arts in Art/Master of Arts in Museum Studies at WIU. To complete this integrated degree plan in Art/Museum Studies students from the College of DuPage should follow the Associate in Arts degree program outlined by the College of DuPage. Students who complete the Associate of Arts degree at the College of DuPage may transfer to WIU and complete their degree in Art in an additional two years. An additional year will be spent completing requirements for the Masters in Museum Studies.

The location of the fifth year of this program is housed at the WIU-Quad Cities Campus Moline, IL with most courses being taught at the Figge Art Museum across the Mississippi River in Davenport, Iowa.
