Bachelor of Music in Music Business

The 2+2 is a four-year plan that leads to a Bachelor of Music degree in Music Business at WIU.

Students intending to complete a baccalaureate degree in Music, Music Business from WIU should follow the Associate in Fine Arts and select coursework from the Audio Production Certificate Degree program outlined in this 2+2 Degree Plan.

Students who complete the two-year degree may transfer to WIU and complete their degree in Music Business in an additional two years.

Notes for LLCC

1. Prerequisite: Passing the Music Theory Entrance exam or completing MUS 100 (offered in Spring and Summer semesters) with a grade of C or higher.
2. ECO 131 (3 SH) at LLCC = ECON 232 at WIU, this course could be added to either the first year or second year schedule, OR taken over the summer.
3. Additional option during the 2nd year at LLCC: CAS 121 (3 SH) could be taken as it transfers as CS 101 at WIU and is a requirement for the MB degree at WIU.
4. MUS 133 may be substituted for class piano at LLCC (4 credit total hours of piano required). Piano Competency and Theory / Aural Skills assessments will be taken prior to 5th semester at WIU. If additional training is deemed necessary, based on the skills assessment, additional coursework in theory and /or piano may be required. A list of WIU competencies in both piano and theory / aural skills is available at LLCC.
5. It is possible a student may start at the 400 level of applied lessons their first semester at WIU, but up to discretion of applied faculty at
