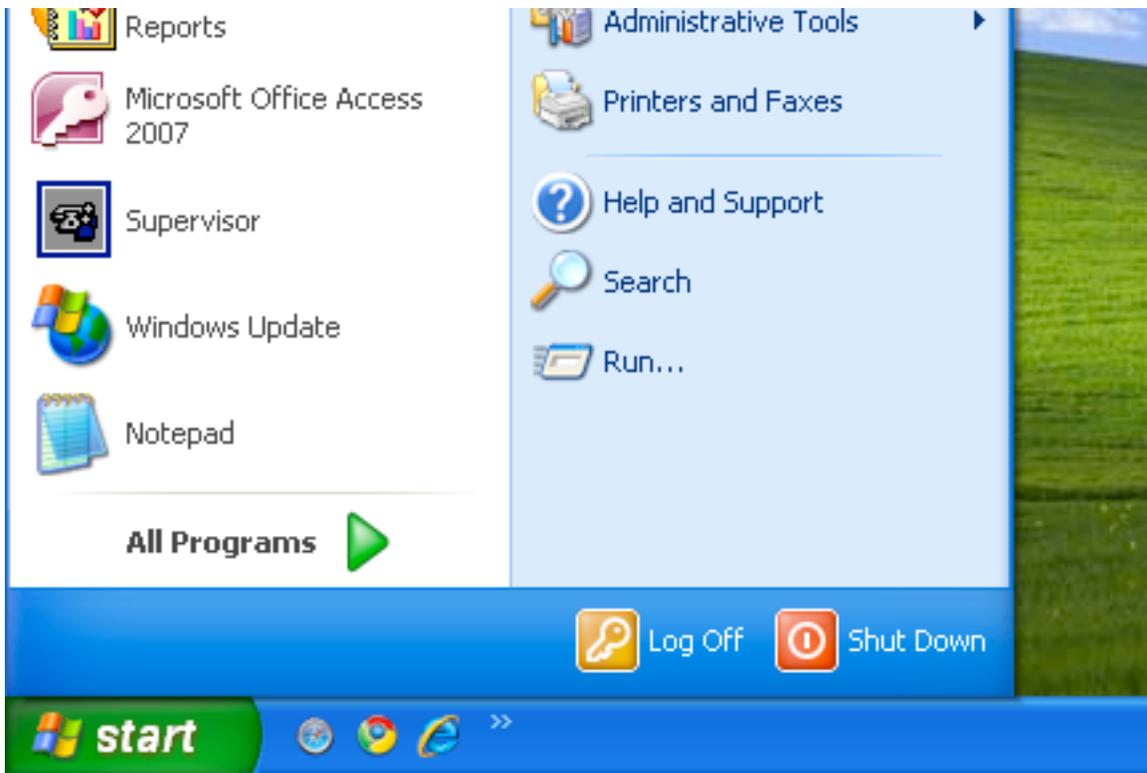
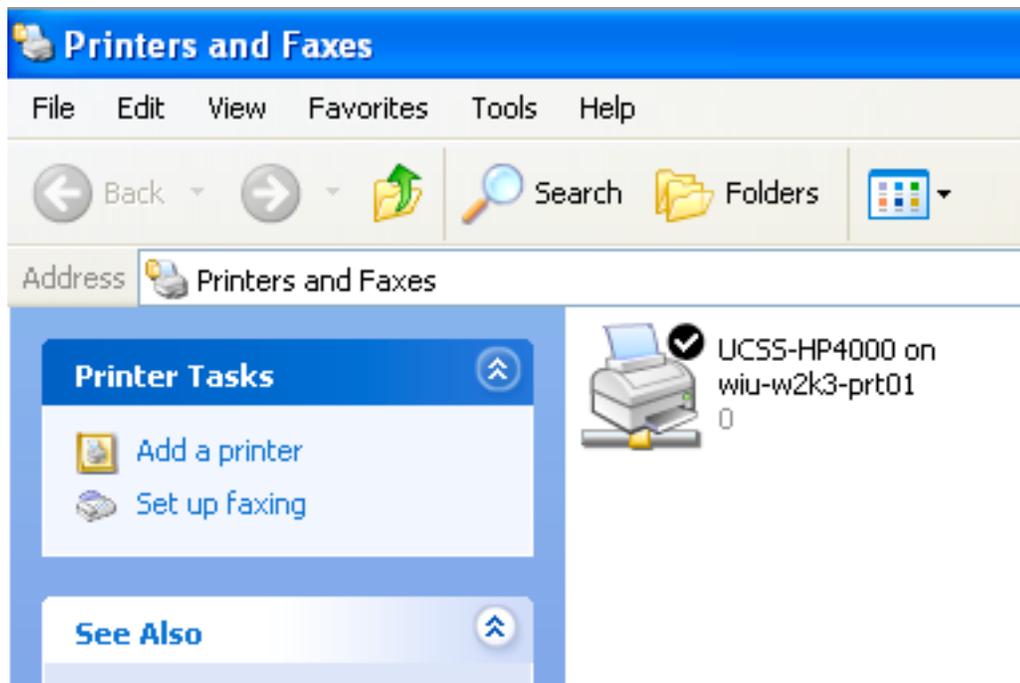


## Adding a network Printer in Windows XP

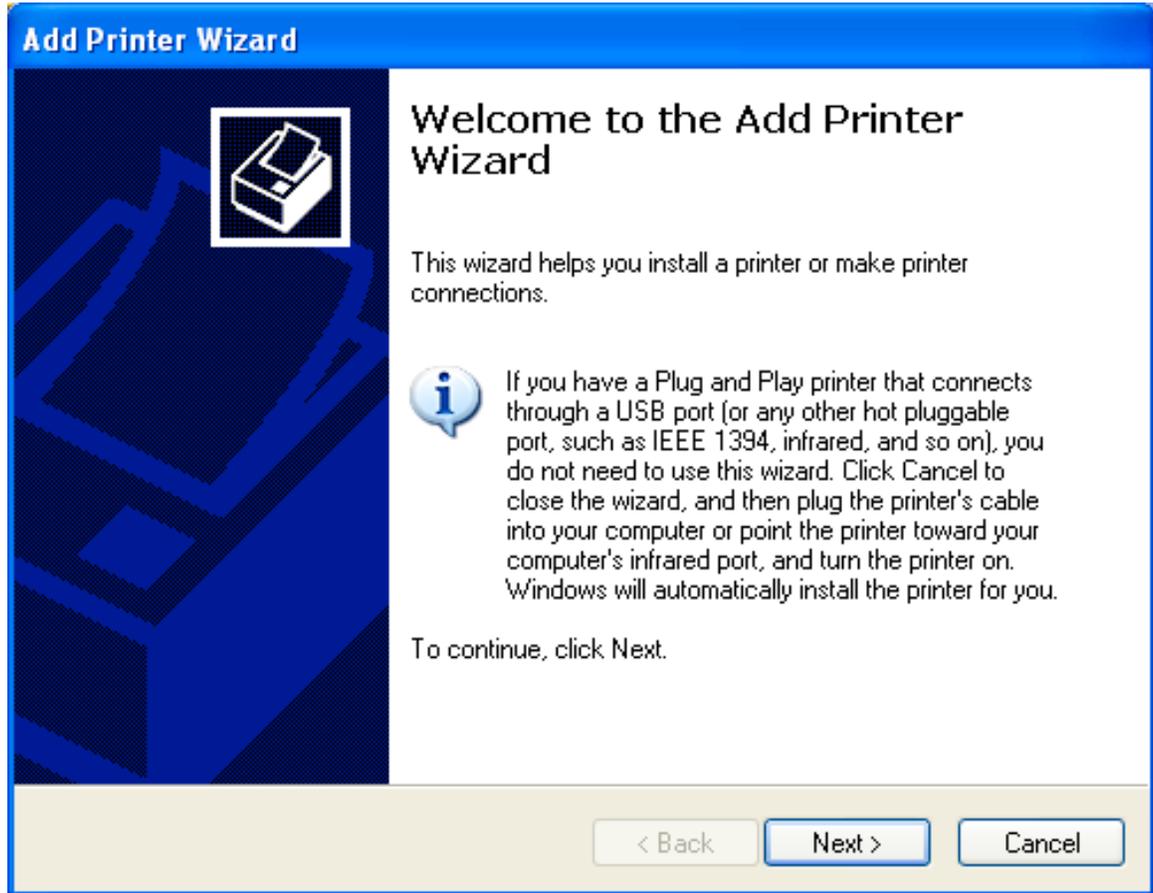
1. Click the Start button and select "Printers and Faxes"



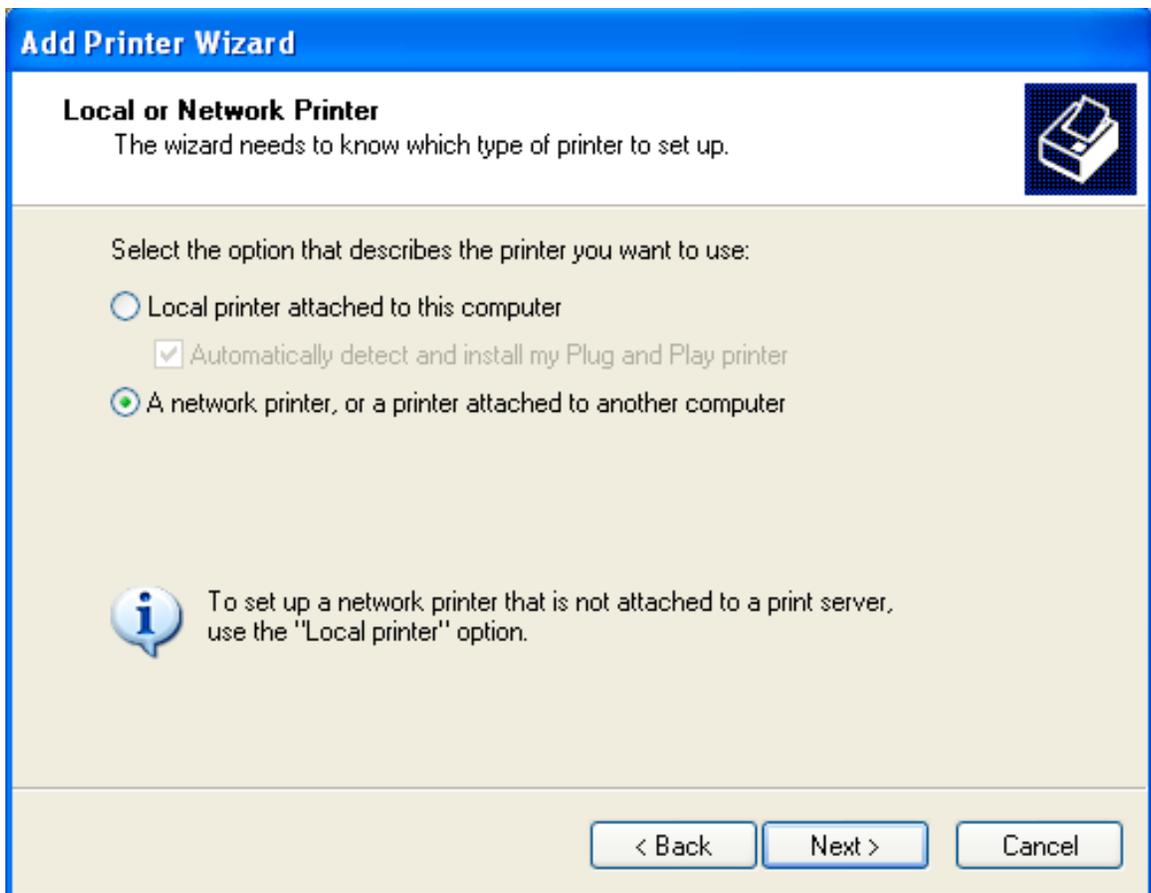
2. Click "Add Printer" to start the "Add Printer Wizard"



3. Click "Next"



4. Select "A network printer, or a printer attached to another computer" and Click "Next"



5. Select "Find a printer in the directory" and Click "Next"

**Add Printer Wizard**

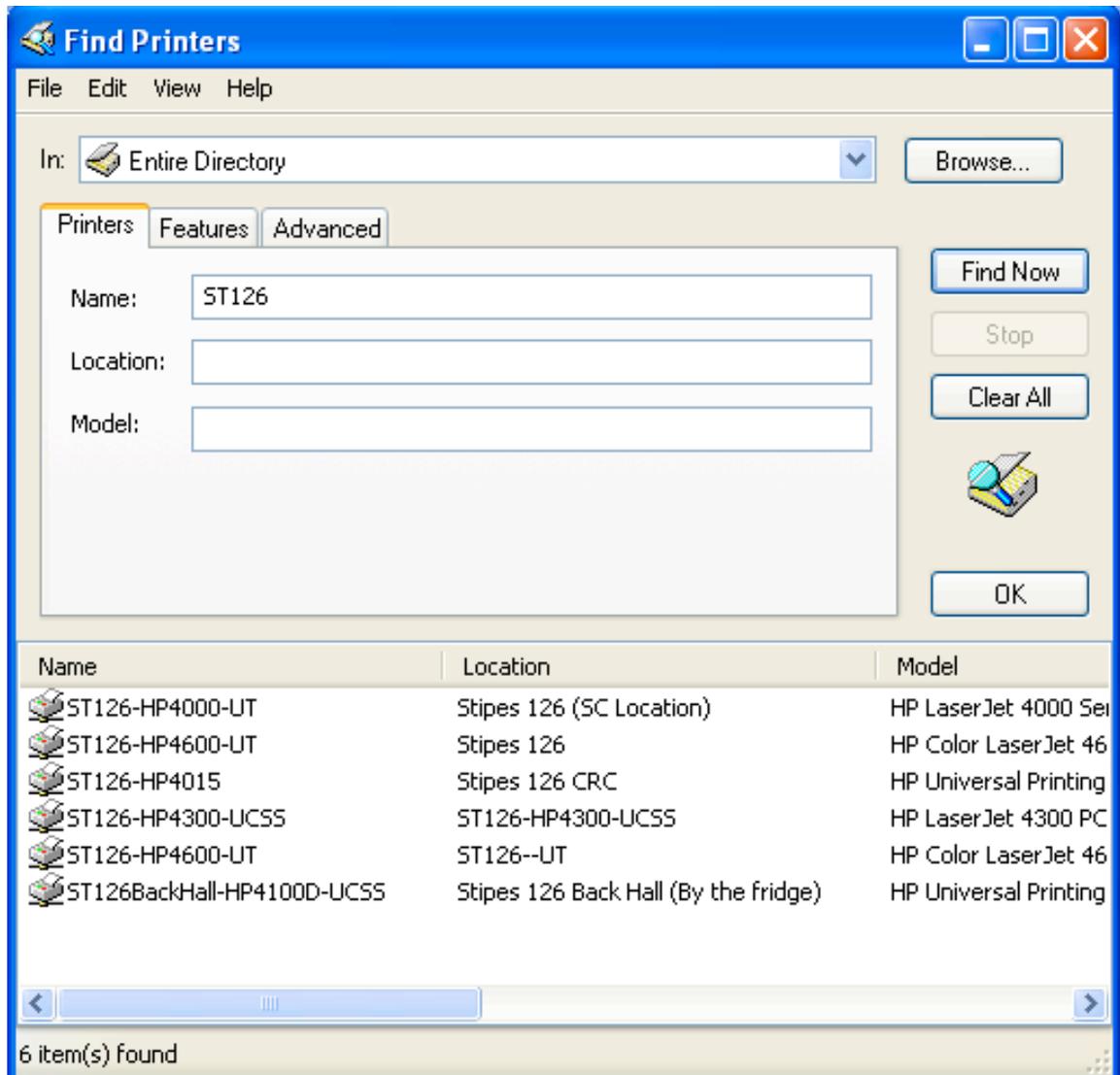

6. Make sure the "In:" field is set to "Entire Directory"



7. In the “Name” field type the first few letters of the printer name and click “OK”

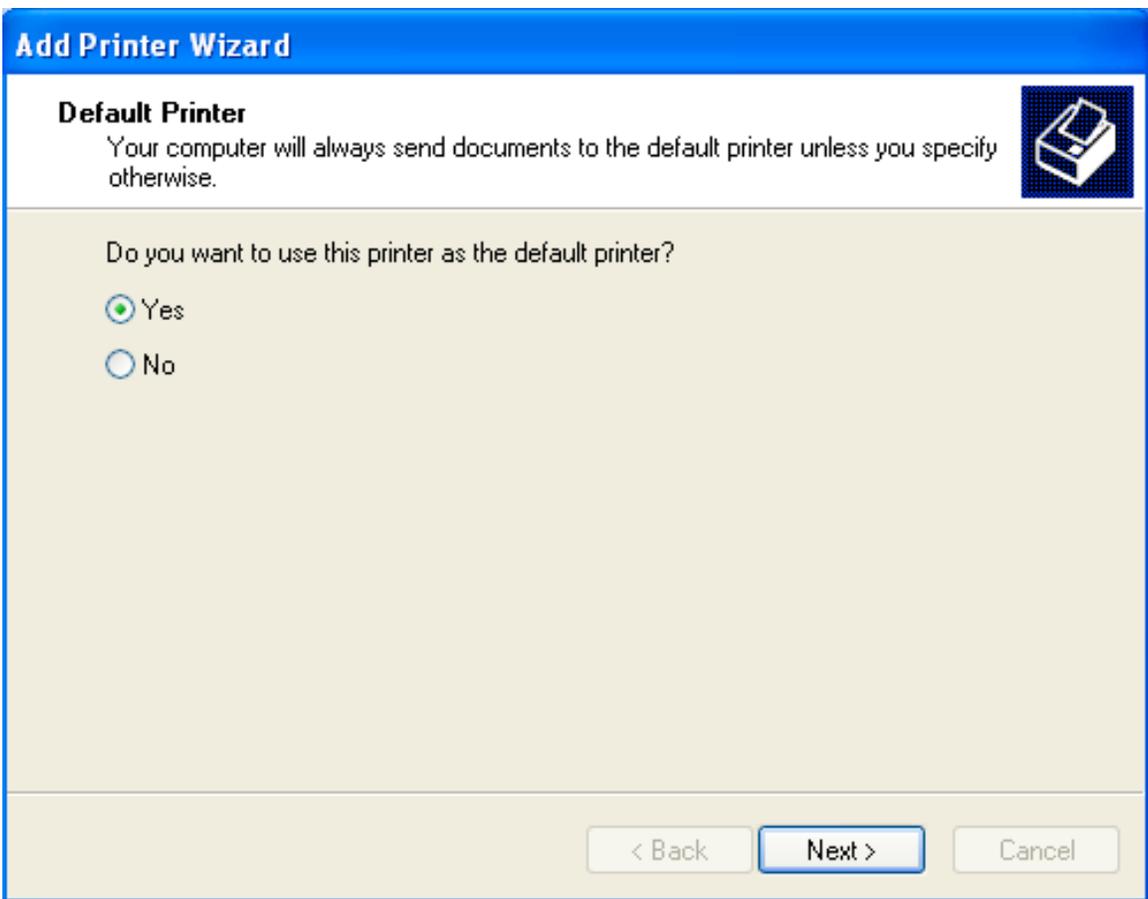
All printers are named using a specific format.

Format: <Building><Room>-<Printer Make and Model>-<Department>

Example: If Communication department HP Laserjet 4200 is in Memorial Hall room 203, then its name will be MH203-HP4200-Comm or something very similar.

It is easiest to type either “MH0”, “MH1”, “MH2”, “MH3” or “MH4” and choose from the several options in the returned list.

8. Choose whether or not you would like this printer to be your default printer and click “Next”



9. Click "Finish"
